

All verses are taken verbatim from the **TANAKH** (Jewish Publishing Society version), also known as the Jewish Holy Scriptures (or the Old Testament or Covenant). ***Who do you think this prophecy is about?*** What do you plan on doing about it? It could change your life for now/eternity!

Genesis 1:1 When God began to create Heaven and earth...

Genesis 1:26 Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.

Micah 5:2 And you, O Bethlehem of Ephrath, least among the clans of Judah, from you one shall come forth to rule Israel for Me-One whose origin is from of old, from ancient times.

Isaiah 9:5 For a child has been born to us, a son has been given us, and authority has settled on his shoulders. He has been named The Mighty God is planning grace, The Eternal Father, a peaceable ruler.

Isaiah 7:14 Assuredly, my Lord will give you a sign of His own accord! Look, the young woman is with child and about to give birth to a son. Let her name him **Immanuel**. (In Hebrew: **God with us**).

Jeremiah 31:31 See, a time is coming-declares the Lord-when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah.

Isaiah 35:3 Requital is coming, the recompense of God-He Himself is coming to give you triumph. Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb shall shout aloud...

Isaiah 43:10 My servant, whom I have chosen, to the end that you may take thought, and believe in Me, and understand that I am He.

Isaiah 43:3 For I the Lord am your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.

Isaiah 53 prophecies: Verse **3:** ...despised, shunned by men. **4:** ...our sickness that he was bearing, our suffering that he endured. **5:** But he was wounded for our sins, crushed because of our iniquities. He bore the chastisement that made us whole, and by his bruises we are healed. **6:** ...and the Lord visited upon him the guilt of us all. **10:** ...that, if he made himself an offering for guilt, he might see offspring and have long life. **11:** "My righteous servant makes the many righteous, it is their punishment that he bears. Assuredly, I will give him the many as his portion, he shall receive the multitude as his spoil, for he exposed himself to death and was numbered among the sinners, where as he bore the guilt of the many and made intercession for sinners.

Daniel 7:13 One like a human being came with the clouds of heaven; he reached the ancient of days and was presented to Him. Dominion, glory, and kingship were given to him; all peoples of every language must serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship, one that shall not be destroyed.

Isaiah 30:9 Now, go write it down on a tablet and inscribe it in a record, that it may be with them for future days, a witness forever. For it is a rebellious people, faithless children, children who refused to heed the instruction of the Lord; who said to the seers, "Do not see," to the prophets, "Do not prophecy truth to us; speak to us falsehoods, prophesy delusions, leave the way! Get off the path! Let us hear no more about the Holy One of Israel!" (This is God's warning to us...is this you?)

JESUS (English for the Hebrew Yeshua, Savior.) **CHRIST** (English for the Greek Christos, anointed).

I **BELIEVE** in the Father, the creator of all things, the source of all life (see Genesis 1:1). I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, who lived and died for me. I believe that He shed His blood on the cross so all my sins would be forgiven, once and for all. I believe

in the Holy Spirit, the comforter, who lives in me and guides me to believe in and follow Jesus. (Well, that's the first step. How are you doing so far? If you can say that and mean it, then proceed.)

I **REPENT** of my sins, the things that I have done that God does not want me to do. I am sorry for sinning against God and people that I have wronged. Please forgive me, Lord. Help me (Holy Spirit) to read the Word (Bible) and find out what God wants me to do. Help me to be more like Jesus every day of my life! Please help me to pray for His help daily (see Matthew 6:9). Thank you for forgiving all my sins, so God can accept me as perfect, and so I can enter Heaven. (So far, so good!) That's it. Jesus promised us in John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life!" God sent Jesus to show us how to live and to forgive all our sins.

That's all there is to it. From here, the real fun begins. It is a lifetime of commitment to Christ and helping the people you meet and telling them this very simple message of salvation. God said to go and make disciples of all nations. If you had \$1,000,000 to give away, and every time you did you got

two more to give away, would you? Well, this message is the same way, only much more valuable to all people. This message can bring eternal life with God and Jesus. There is nothing on earth more precious or valuable than this!
